


Installation of Remote Control Holder _

• Do not leave the remote control mounted on the holder, if it is direct sunlight. Remove the remote control from the holder and put it in the glove compartment. • If double-sided adhesive tape cannot install the holder securely, use screws.




Battery Replacement

Applicable battery: Use two "AAA" sized dry batteries or equivalent.



Opening the battery cover. Push on the cover and slide it as indicated by the arrows then the cover will be removed



Replacing the batteries. Remove the old batteries. Insert new ones matching the (+) and (-) polarities as shown in the diagram inside the remote control

Closing the cover Push the cover in the arrow direction until a click is heard.

In Case of Difficulty

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Problem	Cause	Solution
Remote Control Inoperative.	Reverse placement of battery.	Place the battery correctly into its cradle in the compartment.
	Dead battery.	Replace the battery with a new one.
	Remote Control not pointed toward the head unit or monitor.	Point the remote control directly toward your head unit or monitor.


